## SERVE DAY - A MIRACLE DAY (9-17)

"This is a total God-thing!" That's the phrase that's been used to describe this fall's Serve Day. God has brought three groups together – Children's Hunger Fund, Compass Christian Church, and Dallas Christian College – for HIS purpose of caring for the needs of the under-resourced...

Obviously DCC is doing well by having live, in-person classes this fall. Serve Day was a problem with the COVID 19

pandemic. Serve Day is when all the classes are moved to the field – faculty, staff, administration, and students all take a day off to serve. How could we do service in communities in DFW with the pandemic and safety concerns? We prayed for ideas – we didn't want to call the day off. And we thought a great idea would be to bring the service to us – we could prepare meals for thousands of people! But the cost was way over our Serve Day budget. We called one of our partners, Compass Christian Church in Colleyville, about the possibilities. They loved the idea of preparing meals, which they do every year in a Meal Marathon, but that's not until November. But they knew of a ministry, Children's Hunger Fund, right here in Dallas. A call was made to CHF and they said that they had literally been praying about what to do. They had food supplies for over 1900 boxes of food for the children of Cuba, but didn't have people (because of COVID 19) to put them together. They only had a small window of time before the food would spoil and were praying about next steps. DCC's Serve Day was right in the middle of that window of time! DCC had no funds, but we did have a lot of volunteers. Compass had the funds and was willing to partner with DCC. Children's Hunger Fund had the food, but no volunteers. So, God brought three groups together – Children's Hunger Fund, Compass Christian Church, and Dallas Christian College – for HIS purpose of caring for the under-resourced. Thousands of meals will be prepared to send to the children of Cuba on September 17. Praise God! And you can actually watch some of the service taking place on [DCC's Facebook](#) live.
