IGNITE! Music and Worship Leadership Camp For High School Students

Many of you have been enquiring about our summer camp experience, SALTeens. We are excited to announce that we WILL be having a summer music camp experience, however we are reinventing the opportunity as a **Music and Worship Leadership Camp** called **IGNITE!** The camp will be a one week camp, **June 12-19, 2022**, and students will be in residence on the campus of Dallas Christian College.

This is a new program that is being presented by the DCC

Music & Worship Arts Department and is designed for high school students serving as worship leaders, musicians and tech support in their church's praise bands. This week of instruction will be a great help to those needing to improve their worship leading skills. Classes will be offered by qualified DCC faculty and ministers in: worship theology and philosophy, music theory, audio & visual technology, vocal performance, piano/keyboard, guitar, bass, and drums.

The cost for this seven day event is only \$225. This covers all meals and housing as well as instructional materials and transportation to any off-campus events that might be scheduled. A \$75 deposit along with registration information must be received by May 31, 2022, in order to reserve a place in this camp.
